To develop a formal network for bi-directional sharing of the expertise and resources to improve the performance of teaching-learning processes to such a level that the institutes emerge as Centers of Excellence in Technical Education, Training and Research.

**3. The Understanding**

GIE, Secunderabad as Network Institution, and RGM CET, Nandyal as Network Institute under TEQIP jointly through this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) decide to undertake various activities as listed below (suggested).

- iii. Maintain career, interest and competency profiles of faculty members
- jjj. Organize lectures of experts of RGM CET for students of GIE, Secunderabad.
- kkk. Provide need based training to non-teaching laboratory staff
- lll. Make available library and learning resources to visiting faculty
- mmm. Develop and work on joint proposal of research and consultancy
- nnn. GIE, Secunderabad Organize jointly continuing education program for professionals
- ooo. Organize seminars, conferences and workshops on topics of general interest

**Annexure- III**

- ppp. Organize training and lectures on emerging and thrust areas

- qqq. Share and assist in curriculum development
- rrr. Nominate faculty members of RGM CET to academic bodies of GIE, Secunderabad.
- sss. Make arrangement of stay in hostel for visiting faculty
- ttt. Provide help to develop informal relations with other institute, industry, non-government organization and local bodies to provide the service to community and economy.

For implementing and monitoring of Project GIE, Secunderabad and RGM CET also agree that:

- z. The networking between GIE, Secunderabad and RGM CET will be implemented by, created by creating a Networking Coordination Cell both at GIE, Secunderabad and RGM CET
  - aa. Each such cell will be headed by a faculty nominated by the Principals of the GIE, Secunderabad and RGM CET who shall be designated as Network coordinator and whose main responsibility will be to execute and co-ordinate all activities envisaged under this MoU.
  - bb. GIE, Secunderabad, Secunderabad. and RGM CET will constitute a Network Coordination Committee (NCC) for regular monitoring of the activities and achieving the set targets. The Committee will meet at least once in six months and review the Progress.
  - cc. The composition of the Committee shall be the following:
 

i. Principal & Secretary / Director, GIE, Secunderabad.	Chairman
ii. Principal, RGM CET, Nandyal	Member
iii. Once professor of GIE, Secunderabad.	Member
iv. One professor of RGM CET, Nandyal	Member
v. Network Coordinator, GIE, Secunderabad	Member
vi. Network Coordinator, RGM CET, Nandyal	Member
vii. One SPFU Officer nominated by SPFU Head	Member
  - dd. The Networking Coordinators from GIE, Secunderabad and RGM CET will meet at least once in three months to assess the benefits of networking and resolve any problems that are being faced. A networking progress report will be prepared by the Network Coordinators on a quarterly; basis, which will be submitted to SPFU Head for onward transmission to NPIU.

Regarding the financial arrangements during the Project implementation, GIE, Secunderabad and RGM CET further agree to :

- p. Both the institutes will engage services of the existing faculty and staff for networking arrangement and no additional staff will be provided. Such staff will not be provided any honorarium.
- q. Both the institutes will utilize existing infrastructure for networking arrangement and will create new facilities at the cost TEQIP
- r. All expenses in connection with implementation and monitoring such as TA/DA , boarding / lodging and conveyance of students / faculty /researches will be borne by TEQIP

**4.0 . Settlement of Disputes**

In case of any dispute /differences of opinion or any such mater, decision of the Head of the SPFU will be final and binding on both the parties concerned.

**5.0 Termination of MoU**

If necessary , NCC will meet to review the contents of the MoU and will expand the scope of the MoU as per requirement . The MoU can be terminated by mutual consent of the parties involved with permission from SPFU/NPIU.
