

**TEQIP REVIEW MEETING WITH INSTITUTIONS ON 6th MAY, 2006
AT S.V.BHAVAN, MASAB TANK, HYDERABAD**

1. The Head Quality Assurance of the SPFU welcomed the Principal Secretary, Higher Education, State Project Advisor, members of SPFU and Principals /Nodal Officers of the TEQIP Institutions. Further the participants were informed about the Agenda items and also the discussions that would be taken up during the meeting.
2. The Head Procurement Cell reviewed the procurement of Civil Works and Equipment by the TEQIP participating institutions.
3. The Principal Secretary Higher Education reviewed the status of funds released, actual expenditure with respect to target expenditure and tentatively proposed in consultation with the SPFU officials, the amounts to be released upto 30-9-2006 to JNTUCE,HYD- Rs. 15 million, OUCE,HYD – Rs 15 million, AUCE,VIZAG – Rs 20 million, SVUCE,TPT – Rs 20 million, JNTU,ATP – Rs 10 million, JNTU,KKD – Rs 30 million, OUCT,HYD- Rs 25 million, IST, JNTU,HYD – Rs 30 million, GIOE,SEC'BAD-Rs 10 million, BEC,BPT – Rs 20 million, RGM CET,NDL – Rs 25 million and SNIST,GTK – Rs 20 million.
4. The Principal Secretary, Higher Education also reviewed the position of filling the vacant posts in University Engineering colleges. All colleges except AUCE, Visakhapatnam are permitted to fill the vacant seats as recommended by the Higher Power Committee. It was also informed that very soon G.O. will be released to fill vacant faculty positions in AUCE, Visakhapatnam.
5. Later, the institutions have given their presentations in the prescribed format. The highlights of the presentations:
 - i. Development of automatic evaluation software by GIOE, Sec'bad.
 - ii. Introduction of One student counselors for every 6 students from first year onwards.
 - iii. Civil Works in GIOE, Sec'bad need to be strengthened by providing funds to the tune of Rs 1.313 millions from Minor Works to complete semi-built structure. Old equipment and furniture need to be shifted to the needy Polytechnics i.e., GMR Polytechnic, Gazwel.
 - iv. University of Colorado has come forward to have an MOU between JNTU- University of Colorado and U.S. Bureau of Reclamation in the areas of Water Resources, Irrigation Engineering, Environment and Geomatics.

- v. JNTUCE, Kakinada was advised to take up the activity of de-mineralizing of ground water under Services to Community.
 - vi. OUCE, Hyderabad informed that they have released the advertisement for faculty recruitment stipulating age restriction.
 - vii. AUCE, Visakhapatnam informed that they are starting M.Tech Nano-Technology and that the IRG generated by them is totally remitted into University account and not retained by the institution.
 - viii. SNIST, Ghatkesar entered MoU with 110 industries situated around the college in Cherlapally Industrial Estate for all their Consultancy activities and also Training and Placement requirements of their institution.
 - ix. It was in general observed that most of the institutions have crossed their limits of spending under Equipment category.
 - x. Almost all the institutions have not taken up good number of activities under Networking, Services to Community and Economy development and Tribal Development Plan. The institutions were advised to concentrate more in these activities and undertake quality activities.
6. The Head Programme Cell, informed the institutions to send the required information in the formats sent by NPIU for effective presentation of State's information. The institutions were also requested to send photographs / video clippings of worth mentioning TEQIP activities so as to enable the SPFU to include in the presentation for the 5th JRM .
 7. The institutions were also requested to take up major activities like Joint Research & Consultancies, Joint Academic programmes etc., in addition to the activities presently implemented under Networking.
 8. The institutions viz., Govt Institute of Electronics, Secunderabad, Institute of Science & Technology, O.U. College of Technology and the Private institutions Sreenidhi Institute of Science & Technology, Ghatkesar and Rajeev Gandhi Memorial College of Engineering & Technology, Nandyal were advised to gear up and perform well in to meet their financial targets.
